

FESTIVAL MECHANICS

1. The “**MaPSA FILM FESTIVAL**” will showcase the talents of MAPSA in documenting, filming and sharing the efforts, values and heroic acts within its circle.
2. There will be a “basic filmmaking” workshop to be attended by selected students who show and engage interest in filmmaking. A respected practitioner in the film industry will be invited to be a resource person.
3. **All MaPSA schools** are qualified to participate in the festival. Any available video camcorder or gadget (cellphone camera, tablet camera, digital camera, DSLR camera, etc.) is accepted to be used as filmmaking tools.
4. The festival will be a contest in “filmmaking” and will focus on **existing ideals, exemplary efforts, heroic actions, good practices and extraordinary achievements** of a MaPSA Member School (be it by individuals, groups or programs and systems that could serve as examples and inspiration to others).
5. Entries should be original works produced by students, employees and faculty members of the MAPSA member school.
6. The festival will have two (2) categories:
 - I. DOCUMENTARY (MAX. OF 5 MINUTES)
 - II. SHORT FILM (MAX. OF 5 MINUTES)

All entries should conform to the festival theme:

7. For the Documentary category, each entry should be about individuals, groups or an entity within a MaPSA-Member School that has/have done something remarkable or has been and continuously engaged in a work or action that displays heroism, Catholic values and/or virtues that exemplifies Catholicity. Research work is presumed to be undertaken in this category, as it should feature factual and verifiable content. Each entry should be guided and supported by the school head as the producer of the film.
8. For the Short Feature Film category, each entry should focus on heroism and Catholic values and virtues that could be an inspiration to the youth of today. The actors should be coming exclusively from the school where the filmmaker/s belong. The film must at least have some scenes that involve the campus, uniforms and logo of the school by the filmmaker/s. Each entry should be guided and supported by the school head as the producer of the film.
9. There will be 10 finalists for each category granting 1 final entry per diocese per category. However, in the case

when a diocese will have no entry by choice, the slot will be awarded to the diocese/s based on the rating and ranking of the screening committee.

10. The entry should have a 5-minute running time including credits
11. Entries should not be published or exhibited or entered in other filmmaking competitions prior to submission.
12. Entries that conform to the G or PG classification rating of the Movies and Television Review and Classification Board (MTRCB) would be given priority in the selection of finalists.

14. The entry must be submitted on an MP4 format, HD 720p -1080p is highly encouraged).
15. A “**MaPSA FILM FESTIVAL**” CARAVAN will be organized where all finalists would be showcased in all MaPSA schools. Likewise, it will be the opportune time to realize the festival objectives of reaching all students.
16. Voting for the “**Students’ Choice Award**” will be undertaken also during the CARAVAN.
17. There will be a red carpet - **awarding ceremony** for the winners to culminate the activities of the Festival.




